Background

NOE CPC promotes the use of the Crown Commercial Services framework for the provision of temporary AHP, HSS and Emergency Services staff. The framework has a comprehensive range of options regarding service delivery and a sufficient number of competent suppliers.

NOE CPC members have, in previous iterations of the CCS framework, used a Master Vendor model which has proved reasonably successful, with the supplier market conditioned to supporting this structure.

Following the award of the new CCS framework in April 2014, NOE CPC engaged with stakeholders to establish which route they may wish to take on a collaborative basis.

The conclusion was that a single Master Vendor appointment, established via a competitive further competition, was the preferred model.

The procurement process was therefore run under Lot 2 being the lot for Master Vendor services with all 20 appointed suppliers invited to participate.
