## INFORMATION FOR DRIVERS

Normally it is possible to find a space in the car park at Don Valley House; however it can get very busy at times and there have been occasions when the car park has filled up very early in the morning. Therefore please note the following information about car parking at Don Valley House:

- Please ensure that cars are parked only in the designated area.
- If there are no spaces available, there is off street parking around the area.
- There is an area in the car park that is clearly signposted indicating that it belongs to the adjacent building. This car park is located on the right hand side as you exit the gates to the rear of the building which leads onto the dual carriageway. You are at risk of being blocked in if you park here.

- Disabled car parking spaces are available and are only to be used by Blue Badge holders.
