

## How to become a supplier to Workforce Alliance

New and existing suppliers have a real opportunity to help Workforce Alliance to support the NHS in addressing the staffing crisis and delivering a sustainable workforce model.

An increasing amount of NHS procurement is done through a range of frameworks and pretendered contracts. When Workforce Alliance identifies new health workforce related requirements for our NHS members, we follow the formal process under EU legislation.

We undertake supplier engagement as early as possible in the procurement process, enabling the market to inform and help shape the development of our framework agreements.

To become a supplier on a Workforce Alliance framework, you will need to respond successfully to a Contract Notice published in the Supplement to the Official Journal of the European Union (OJEU).

There are several ways to find opportunities to become a Workforce Alliance supplier:

- Register with <u>Tenders Electronic Daily</u> (TED) for alerts relevant to your business area
- Register for relevant alerts from <u>Contracts Finder</u> for contracts worth over £10,000
- Monitor the individual Workforce Alliance partners websites for tender opportunities

Workforce Alliance has adopted several initiatives to encourage and facilitate SME involvement in our procurements wherever possible. We want to get suppliers best solutions; we encourage innovation and value and not simply lowest cost.
